



By Rail From Sheffield Midland Station take the Supertram, accessed via the overall bridge, to the Cathedral stop. The regular **40 bus** leaves the Interchange opposite the station and stops on Church Street.

St James St. leads off the Western side of the Cathedral courtyard.

By Car – City Centre car parks are often full. Reliable parking can be found at Meadowhall (off the M1 Junction 34) or Parkway Park & Ride (off Sheffield Parkway A57, just to the East of the City Centre).
